
## Tacoma Rialto theater Oscar party

This year in Tacoma the Rialto Theater will be holding its 4th annual Oscar awards party on March 21st 1999 at 4:30 p.m.


Tickets are \$15 and will be sold by phone through ticketmaster or in person at the Broadway center




